 - a. System level procedures for resolution & review: Principal; School level media technology committee; System level media technology committee; School board
 - b. Divisive Concepts Complaint Resolution Process (HB 1084): Deals with race and seeks to keep teaching on racial topics neutral

 - i. We are outperformed; high beginning, very low distinguished percentages

- ii. What are other counties doing? Union has a STEM Academy; Fannin is beginning one in middle grades;
- iii. How do we move these bands?
 - 1. Possible extra support for a targeted group of students
 - a. i.e. continue year-long classes for 9th Llt/Comp and Algebra1, possibly begin year-long science and social studies
 - b. SPED and ESOL support for learning strategies and differentiation
 - c. BE MORE STRATEGIC WITH SCHEDULING to support struggling and at-risk students and to support a more rigorous academic schedule for university bound students

4. Other Topics

- a. UNG and Dual Enrollment
 - i. inclement weather: D.E. schedule will trump the high school schedule (i.e. 2 hour delay).
- b. Feedback for Curriculum Delivery
 - i. **Content Mastery:** providing extra help and support; learning more by practicing content for mastery (parent feedback)
 - ii. **Engagement in the Classroom:** delivery and content knowledge are present and strong, but weakness includes receiving feedback from the students during the lessons (principal feedback)
- c. Accelerated Learning (AP)
 - i. Spring 2023 meeting for parents and students: informational and reading scores; planning ahead; practicing with PSAT 2 or 3 times before SAT

 - i. Workforce talent; career outlook for Georgia; future opportunities within and outside of Gilmer County; how to challenge and encourage students to ambitiously pursue pathways to careers
