Judy Shaw (1957-2019) practiced nursing for 40 continuous years in the North Georgia and Atlanta area. The majority of these were at Piedmont Hospital. She was a graduate of the Georgia Baptist School of Nursing, now an entity of Mercer University. During these years she provided care and service to people in many stages of life, a nurse on the hospital floor in the ER, ICU, CCU, nursing home facilities and in most recent years hospice and case management. Judy had great compassion for those who had the greatest need, the geriatric and the terminally ill patient. The desire to serve these groups became her passion. She made every effort to fill their physical and emotional needs. Often times this meant covering a shift for a co-worker, or delivering much needed medical supplies on a day off.....in the middle of the night or holding the hand of a patient or the hand of a family member. Judy received recognition and accolades for her selflessness over the years. She received the Piedmont DAISY Award on two occasions.. “The DAISY Award for extraordinary nurse recognizes the super-human work nurses do every day.”

Judy’s languages of love were the ‘act of service’ and the ‘gift of giving’. Her ‘act of service’ was evident throughout the Piedmont family and in the community. Her ‘gift of giving’ was manifest through her generosity to friends and family far & near. Family members lovingly referred to Judy as our ‘red headed angel’ for the care and gifts she gave so unselfishly throughout her life.
